

## **1854 TREATY AUTHORITY VACANCY ANNOUNCEMENT**

**POSITION:** Field Conservation Officer; (funded by COPS Hiring Program)  
**LOCATION:** NE 1854 Ceded Territory (Two Harbors to Grand Portage)  
**SALARY:** Start at \$37,440; benefits include: health, dental, 401K...  
**OPENING DATE:** January 14, 2012  
**CLOSING DATE:** January 31, 2012

### **DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES:**

The Conservation Officer will perform enforcement duties in the off-reservation land and water areas of the Ceded Territory of the Lake Superior Chippewa, as defined in the 1854 Treaty.

### **MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS:**

1. Must be 21 years of age and a citizen of the US.
2. Must be licensed or eligible to be licensed by the Minnesota Police Officer Standards and Training (POST) Board by February 29, 2012
3. Possess a valid U.S. driver's license, eligible to acquire a MN driver's license, and be insurable under the 1854 Treaty Authority Insurance Policy.
4. Applicant must not have been convicted of an 1854 Conservation Code violation and or Minnesota DNR violation, and must agree to submit to an extensive Criminal Background Check/Investigation.
5. Physically and mentally able to perform strenuous duties in all adverse conditions and locations. Must pass a physical examination by a licensed physician; pass a psychological evaluation and a physical fitness test.
6. Native American preference may apply.
