Q: Does camp cost anything to attend?

A: No! *Agaaming Aki* is FREE! All expenses for camping, food and activities are included for Bois Forte youth participants.

Q: “How do I get there”?

A: 1854 and the *Agaaming Aki* planning team are working out the details to get a shuttle van to pick up any Bois Forte youth from their home Monday July 18th, and return them Friday July 22nd. We got you!

Q: “My kid is an 8th grader – are they old enough to attend?”

A: Yes! Although the planning team is targeting High School aged youth for *Agaaming Aki*, responsible and independent middle schoolers are welcome to participate. Multiple siblings? We'd be happy to have you.

*Q: Where do the participants stay when they attend *Agaaming Aki*?*

A: *Agaaming Aki* is a week-long outdoor camping experience; youth participants will tent it on the Grand Portage Reservation. Day trips will be taken out to Isle Royale and other sites within the community.

Q: “When do I have to decide by”?
